How will H1N1 affect Dane County this fall? The answer is unclear, but one thing is certain - preparation is a key part of minimizing the impact. The Public Private Partnership of Dane County is pleased to offer FREE OF CHARGE a “Workplace Preparations for H1N1” workshop.

This workshop will provide up-to-date information about the H1N1 virus situation, risks of H1N1, best practices around preventing and treating the virus, and reducing the spread and impact of H1N1 in your organization. Organizational recovery issues will be discussed and information about upcoming vaccination programs will also be shared. There will also be an opportunity to have your questions answered by local public health and medical professionals, along with selected business and academia representatives.

The H1N1 flu strain is a novel virus, the impacts of this strain may change as the virus evolves. Employees may be at risk of getting sick with H1N1, as well as passing the strain to others in their families and communities. There is an additional risk of spreading the virus between employees and clients. This risk may change throughout the fall as more time is spent indoors.

Who Should Attend? The “Workplace Preparations for H1N1” workshop is intended for anyone charged with decision-making responsibility covering emergency response along with human resources and operational functionality within the public, private and non-profit sectors of Dane County.
