PLAN COMMISSION - November 10, 2008

The regular monthly meeting of the Plan Commission was called to order at 7:02 p.m. in the Community Meeting Room of the Kennedy Administration Building by Van Dinter. Members present: Bowen, Clark, Grosskopf, Manering, Robinson, Trotter, and Van Dinter. Members absent: None. Also attending were: Terry Enge, Bill von Rutenberg, and Tom Wilson.

For matters not on the agenda, after appropriate comments Van Dinter asked for a moment of silence for Bernard Kennedy who was buried today, which was then observed. There were no other comments.
