

TOWN OF WESTPORT

PLAN COMMISSION - July 13, 2009

The regular monthly meeting of the Plan Commission was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in the Community Meeting Room of the Bernard J. Kennedy Administration Building by Van Dinter. Members present: Bowen, Clark, Grosskopf, Robinson, and Van Dinter. Members absent: Trotter and Manering. Also attending were: Terry Enge, Bill von Rutenberg and Tom Wilson.

The Chair opened the Public Hearing on the Comprehensive Plan Amendment for the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (CORP) at 7:01 p.m. After opening comments by Wilson and after Wilson provided comments from Judy Borke, the public hearing was closed by the Chair at 7:05 p.m. after asking for comments three times without reply.

Nobody was present to comment on matters not on the agenda. The minutes of the June 8, 2009 regular meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Bowen, second Grosskopf.

Enge reported on the work of the Park Committee. Bowen reported on the work of the Historic Preservation Committee.

Plan Commission Resolution 09-01 (Recommend Comprehensive Plan Amendment Approval, Add CORP), was adopted on the CORP as presented with a revision to address Judy Borke's comment about the small park in Riverview Gardens on River Road, on a motion by Robinson, second Grosskopf.

After a presentation by Wilson, questions and comments, the Stormwater and Erosion Control Ordinance Revision as presented was recommended for adoption by the Town Board on a motion by Grosskopf, second Robinson.

Van Dinter and Wilson reported on the work of the Waunakee/Westport Joint Planning Committee and Middleton/Westport Joint Zoning Committee specifically as to the Bishops Bay addition development annexation status.

No Miscellaneous Matters or Forthcoming Events were raised.

Motion to adjourn by Robinson, second Bowen. The meeting adjourned at 7:37 p.m.
