

## TOWN OF WESTPORT

PLAN COMMISSION - September 21, 2009

The regular monthly meeting of the Plan Commission was called to order at 7:02 p.m. in the Community Meeting Room of the Bernard J. Kennedy Administration Building by Van Dinter. Members present: Bowen, Clark, Grosskopf, Manering, Robinson, and Van Dinter. Members absent: Trotter. Also attending were: Terry Enge, Bill von Rutenberg, Eric Sullivan, and Tom Wilson.

Eric Sullivan was present to comment on matters not on the agenda regarding drainage issues he is having on Manchester Crossing in the Village which he believes is coming from properties in the Town. The minutes of the August 10, 2009 regular meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Grosskopf, second Robinson.

Enge reported on the work of the Park Committee. Bowen reported on the work of the Historic Preservation Committee.

Various Dane County Ordinance Amendments Regarding Changing Topography Near Lot Lines (O.A.'s 13, 16, and 17, 2009-10) were recommended for approval to the Board on a motion by Manering, second Grosskopf, by a vote of 5-1 (Van Dinter dissenting).

It was recommended to the Board that it take no action on the Town of Oregon Comprehensive Plan Amendment as usual on a motion by Robinson, second Grosskopf.

Van Dinter and Wilson advised the Commission of work by the Waunakee/Westport Joint Planning Committee and the Middleton/Westport Joint Zoning Committee.

For Miscellaneous Matters or Forthcoming Events raised, Wilson advised the Commission of the MGE/Switch Midwest zoning application filing for the Hovde/Kennedy Commercial properties and of the CTH K repaving informational meeting being held at the Town Meeting Room on Wednesday night at 5:30 pm; and Bowen advised the Commission of a story on the invasive Spiny Water Flea being found in Lake Mendota and raised concerns about the boats stored on the north side of CTH M across from Skipper Buds.

Motion to adjourn by Bowen, second Grosskopf. The meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
