Residential Recycling Guidelines

Commingled Containers

All containers may be commingled and put in the recycling container for collection.

Aluminum: Cans and Foil
Rinse Clean



Glass: Clear, Green, and Brown Bottles and Jars
Rinse Clean
Remove Caps



*No Window Glass, Pyrex, Glassware,
Light Bulbs, or Ceramics*

Plastic: Containers #1-7
Rinse Clean
Flatten
Drain Automotive Containers Well
No Plastic Bags or Styrofoam



Steel: Steel and Tin Cans
Rinse Clean
Remove Labels



Mixed Paper

All paper may be commingled and put in paper bags and placed next to the recycling container for collection.



Acceptable Materials

Adding Machine Tape	File Folders
Beverage Cases	Magazines
Carbonless Forms	Manilla Folders
Cereal Boxes	Newspaper
Colored Paper	Paperboard
Computer Paper	Phone Books
Copy Paper	Post-It Notes
Corrugated Cardboard	Typing Paper
Envelopes (includes windowed)	White Letterhead
Fax Paper	Writing Paper

* Cardboard should not be larger than 3" x 3"

No Napkins, Paper towels, Tissue, Paper Plates, or Waxed Material
