MILL ROAD AND WOODLAND DRIVE CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

The reconstruction of Mill Road and Woodland Drive are scheduled for improvements this construction season. This is a joint project between the Village of Waunakee and the Town of Westport.

MILL ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Mill Road will be reconstructed from Woodland Drive to Arboretum Drive beginning the week of June 1st. As part of the Mill Road reconstruction, we will be improving the alignment as well as widening of the existing bridge.

In order to accommodate the bridge work and the construction activities, **Mill Road will be closed to all thru traffic from Woodland Drive to Arboretum Drive beginning the week of June 14th for the duration of the project.** However, access to Sawmill Court will be maintained. We ask that you please find an alternate route during this time.

The Mill Road project will include the road and bridge reconstruction work as well as new curb and gutter, ditch improvements, storm sewer improvements, new asphalt pavement and installation of new on-road bike lanes and a separate recreational path. The project is anticipated to be completed by the end of August.

WOODLAND DRIVE CONSTRUCTION

Upon completion of the Mill Road project, Woodland Drive will be reconstructed from Cobblestone Drive to Mary Lake Road. Woodland Drive will also be closed due to work on the Six Mile Creek Bridge and to accommodate construction, and local access will be maintained.

The construction is anticipated to begin in September and is anticipated to be completed by the end of October.

The Woodland Drive project will include ditch and culvert improvements, storm sewer improvements, new asphalt pavement and installation of new on-road bike lanes and a separate recreational path.
