

TOWN OF WESTPORT

TOWN BOARD - Monday, April 5, 2010

The regular semi-monthly meeting of the Town Board was called to order in the Community Meeting Room of the Bernard J. Kennedy Administration Building at 7:01 p.m. by Van Dinter. Members present: Enge, Robinson, Sipsma, and Van Dinter. Members absent: Von Rutenberg. Also present: Brent Neevel and Tom Wilson.

No one was present to comment on matters not on the agenda. The minutes of the March 15, 2010 regular meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Robinson, second Enge.

A Driveway/Access/Utility/Road Opening Permit was granted to Gary Ripp on Easy Street as requested (variance to allow 40 foot width) due to the nature of the commercial activity (semi trailers entering farm field off town road) and because the characteristics of land (agricultural in nature) require a drive of greater width in the Board's discretion as allowed by ordinance and in order to preserve the road edges, with the exact location and construction of the driveway to be approved by Even, Ziegler, Wilson and Van Dinter, on a motion by Sipsma, second Robinson.

Wilson reported on the status of the Interoperable (Emergency) Radio Network matter. No action was necessary at this time since the Board previously gave authority to Van Dinter to act consistent with the Board's stated position.

The Audit Committee recommended payment of bills as presented by the Administrator after questions were answered. Van Dinter reported on meetings of the plan commission/committees.

There were no Administrative Matters raised. For Miscellaneous Business or Forthcoming Events, Wilson advised the Board of several upcoming meetings including the Annual Town Meeting on April 13, 2010.

Current bills as presented by the Administrator were paid on a motion by Sipsma, second Robinson.

Motion to adjourn by Sipsma, second Robinson. The meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
