

TOWN OF WESTPORT

Annual Town Budget Hearing and Special Town Meeting
For 2012 Budget
November 15, 2011

A public hearing on the 2012 proposed budget was called to order at 7:03 p.m. in the Community Meeting Room of the Kennedy Administration Building on Tuesday, November 15, 2011, by the Chair, John Van Dinter. Also attending were Pat Robinson, Maureen Van Dinter, Ryan Dostalek, Terry Enge, Ken Sipsma, Brad Robinson, Bill von Rutenberg, Bob Anderson and Tom Wilson.

The proposed budget was presented, discussed, comments made, and questions answered. The public hearing was closed at 7:09 p.m.

The special Town Meeting was then convened immediately by the Town Chair John Van Dinter.

The minutes of the November 10, 2010 meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Ken Sipsma, second Bill von Rutenberg, by a vote of 8-0.

The road and bridge expenditures in the amount of \$791,521.00, as shown in the proposed budget as presented, including the cost of appropriate 2011 carry over projects, and as available to the Town under the current State levy restrictions, were approved on a motion by Ken Sipsma, second Ryan Dostalek, by a vote of 8-0.

The tax levy of \$1,420,221.00, as shown in the proposed budget as presented, and as available to the Town under the current State levy restrictions, was recommended for approval on a motion by Ken Sipsma, second Maureen Van Dinter, by a vote of 8-0.

Motion to adjourn by Ryan Dostalek, second Pat Robinson. Meeting adjourned at 7:16 p.m.
