



2023 Town of Westport Road Improvements **COBBLESTONE LANE**

Weekly Update – July 23rd, 2023

The reconstruction of COBBLESTONE LANE from Woodland Drive to Hunt Club Way is scheduled to begin Friday August 4th, 2023.

Tentative schedule beginning August 7th.

Excavation of roadway (2-3 weeks)

Preparation and installation of 4ft wide concrete ribbon curb (1 week)

Curing of concrete (1 week) no access to driveways during this time

Grade and compact the road in preparation for the new asphalt surface (1-2 weeks)

Asphalt paving (1 day) no access to roadway during paving and curing of asphalt.

Restoration and installation of mailboxes (1-2 weeks)

In preparation for construction, we ask that any landscaping or private underground utilities that may be located within the construction area or immediately adjacent to the existing road (such as an invisible dog fence, lawn sprinkling systems, special topsoil's, decorative fencing, etc.) be removed and salvaged by the property owners. Please note that restoration of the areas that are disturbed during construction will be limited to turf reestablishment. The areas disturbed will generally be limited from the existing edge of pavement to the bottom of the drainage swale. If desired, any decorative or specialized landscaping such as pavers, flowers, stonework will need to be restored by the property owners at their expense. Concrete driveways will be removed approximately 12 feet from the edge of the driveway. This will allow the contractor to match the grade into the new roadway properly.

The Waunakee Postmaster has instructed the contractor to install a temporary mailbox station. The mailbox station will be near the intersection of Hunt Club and Cobblestone Lane. Deliveries to the temporary mailbox station will begin August 4th. Please contact the post office if you have any questions regarding specific mail deliveries. Also, please notify other delivery services that the roads may not be accessible during the daily construction hours, and alternate delivery locations may be necessary.

Existing mailboxes will be removed and placed in the property owner's yard. We request that the property provide safe storage of the mailboxes until it's time for the contractor to reinstall the mailboxes.

We do not anticipate any disruption of refuse pick-up during the resurfacing. Please just put your receptacles out in your driveways and the contractors will work with the refuse company to collect the refuse and recycling.
