



2023 Town of Westport Water Main Improvements

August 3rd 2023 Newsletter

The Town of Westport will be completing a water main improvements along Willow Road. The water main will be extended from the existing hydrant near the bridge crossing, then west thru the corn field about 700 feet. (see attached simplified map) The proposed water main is part of a larger project that will provide water looping to improve the redundancy of the Town water system. We anticipate completion of the work in approximately 8-10 weeks, weather permitting. The project has been publicly bid and the Town Board has awarded the project to SPEEDWAY SAND & GRAVEL, INC. 8500 Greenway Blvd., Suite 202 Middleton, WI 53562. Construction is anticipated to begin in late August. Please sign up on the Town website to receive weekly updates.

The contractors will remove portions of the existing asphalt pavement and install the watermain and then patch the roadway with new asphalt surface. The final pavement surface will be completed with the CTH M Highway project. The roadway will be closed to vehicular travel throughout the project. Access will be maintained from the East end of Willow Road. Vehicles may encounter brief delays during construction..

All lawn and terrace areas that are disturbed during the construction will be restored with grass seed. We ask that you please water and maintain these areas as needed after they are restored to promote new growth.

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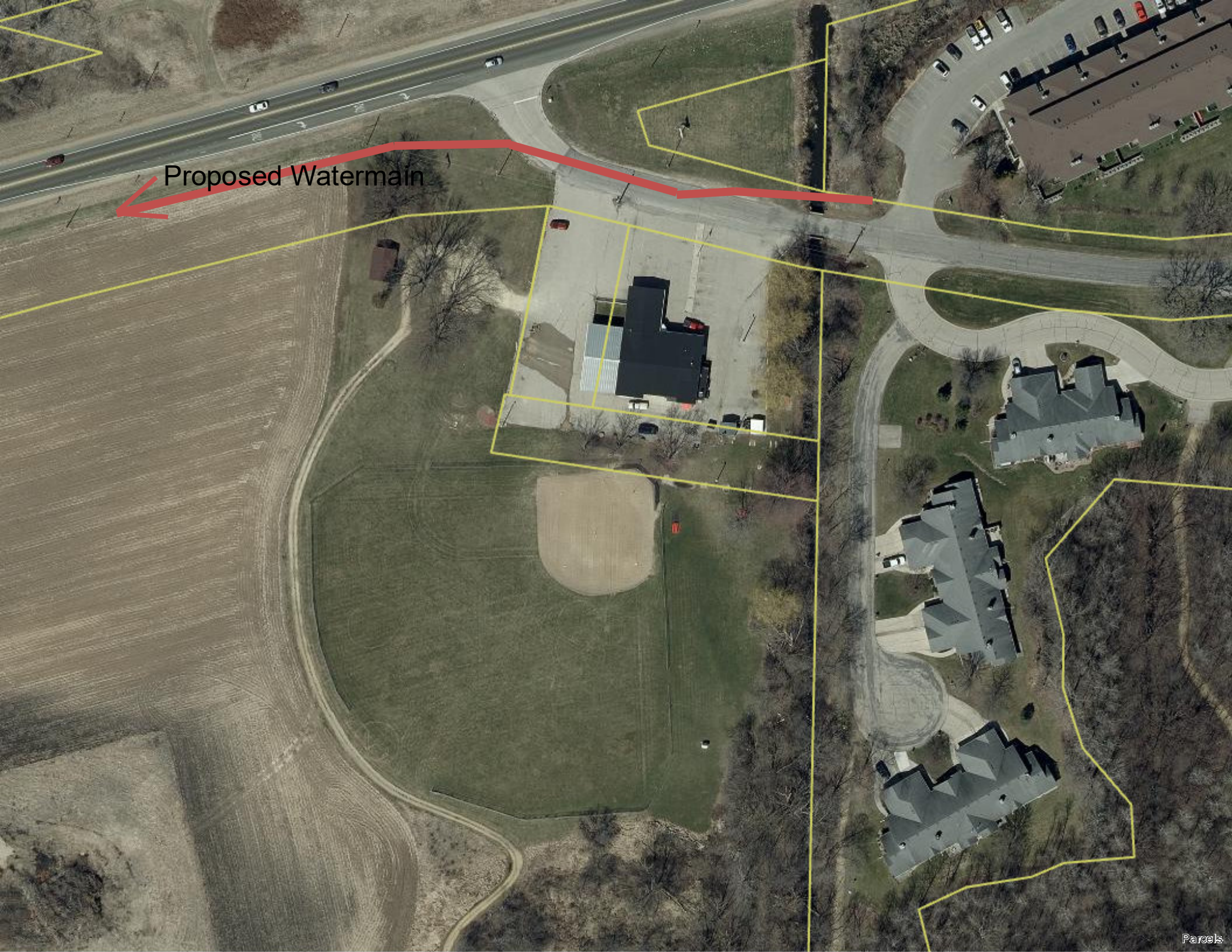
